



Business event AdRia4Blue 2020 promotion of blue economy and sustainable development

AdRia4Blue 2020 event will be held from 11th to 12th June 2020 in Rijeka, Croatia, at the occasion of the 21st International Sailing Race 'Fiumanka' in the year in which Rijeka becomes the European Capital of Culture.

The AdRia4Blue is an international economic match - making event that brings together four helix stockholders with the aim of promoting and encouraging the Blue Economy and Sustainable Development. As we know, the Organization for Economic Co-operation and Development (OECD) predicts that the global maritime economy will grow at twice the rate of the mainstream economy by 2030. The potential of the Blue Economy around Adriatic and Mediterranean Sea basin can play a significant role for sustainable growth and job creation, whilst safeguarding its unique natural and cultural capital.

Recognizing the importance and the potential of the Blue Economy for Sustainable Growth and Job Creation, the Croatian Chamber of Economy - Rijeka County Chamber organized first edition of the economic event AdRia4Blue in June 2019.

AdRia4Blue 2020 will focus on the **blue&green economy and the Mediterranean quality of life**, particularly on:

- Food and health from and by the sea
- Sustainable fisheries and aquaculture
- Gastro-oenological products
- Eco products and new technologies

Our intention is to emphasize the need of strengthening the local producers supply. We will encourage their integration and marketing of products within the hospitality sector, as well as further development of the visibility of the entire tourist, oenological and gastronomic offer of the coastal area. The Mediterranean Quality of Life is listed on the UNESCO's Representative List of the Intangible Cultural Heritage of Humanity - our goal is to promote it and to contribute to the high positioning of the Mediterranean in the demanding gourmet scene of the world.

Also, following CCE CC Rijeka membership in ASCAME, AdRia4Blue 2020 will host the next Mediterranean MedaCity 2020 City Forum- one-day conference that will address the specific challenges and development of Mediterranean cities. The Forum is conceived as a synergy of the Rijeka 2020 - European Capital of Culture and AdRia4Blue 2020, and takes place in the context of Croatia's EU Council Presidency.
